

1.G-2021 Board Onboarding Policy

Purpose and Scope:

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that new Governors to the Board of Governors of St. Mary's University are in a position to fulfill their governance responsibilities and Governor's duties as soon as possible after they are elected to the Board.

1. Roles and Responsibility

1.1 Onboarding of new Governors to the Board of Governors is the responsibility of the Senior Executive (Board Chair, Board Vice-Chair, President, and Chancellor).

2. Onboarding

- 2.1 Governor onboarding will take place as soon as reasonably possible after the Governor(s) is elected and will be initiated by the Senior Executive through the Board Secretary.
- 2.2 For the purposes of providing assistance, information, and coaching on a one-to-one basis outside of regular Board meetings, the Board Chair or designate will serve as a mentor to new Governors.
- 2.3 New Governors will be contacted by the Board Chair to welcome them to the Board, to answer any questions they may have, to inform them they will be receiving onboarding documentation, and to inform them they will attend an onboarding meeting with the Senior Executive and other new Governors.
- 2.4 In advance of the onboarding session, new Governors will be provided with copies of the following documentation immediately after their appointment, by the Board Secretary.
 - a) Bylaws
 - b) Confidentiality Policy and Conflict of Interest Statement
 - c) Board Structure
 - d) Governor contact information, roles and terms
 - e) Board Committee list
 - f) Terms of Reference for Board Committees
 - g) Sample of Board meeting package
 - h) Strategic Plan
