- Designing a Yearly Training Plan including organizing and running practices, and attending competitions, meetings and team functions.
- Utilizing appropriate tactical and technical strategies during competition.
- Ability to put coaching theory into practice.
- Analyzing performance and giving feedback.
- Supporting and acting in accordance to the strategic directions and initiatives of the Athletics and Recreation Department and the University as they relate to student athlete support, promotion, , and community relations.
- Hiring required team staff.
- Ensuring the appropriate academic standards of the student athletes are monitored and met.
