

How to Pay Your Registration Deposit

A \$200 non-refundable registration deposit is required to accept your offer of admission and allow you to register for courses. This amount will be credited to your account and will go towards you first semester's tuition and fees.

There are two ways to make this payment. Note that we do not accept in-person payments.

Option 1: Credit Card on your myStMU account

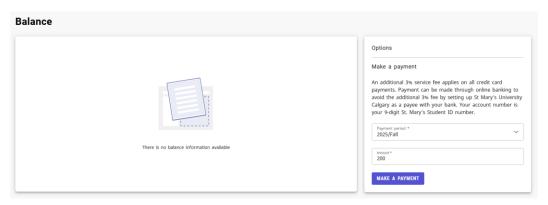
1. Login to your <u>myStMU</u> self-service account. Your username and password were sent when you applied to the email address you entered on your application.



2. Hover over the **Finances** tab, then click **Balance**. Note that there will NOT be a charge on your account as you are paying a deposit, not a fee.

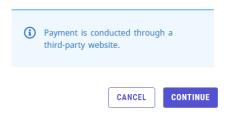


3. Under Payment period, select the term you are beginning your studies, and under Amount, enter 200.

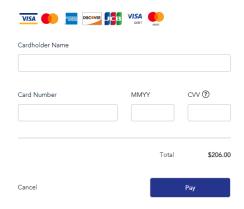


4. Click Continue

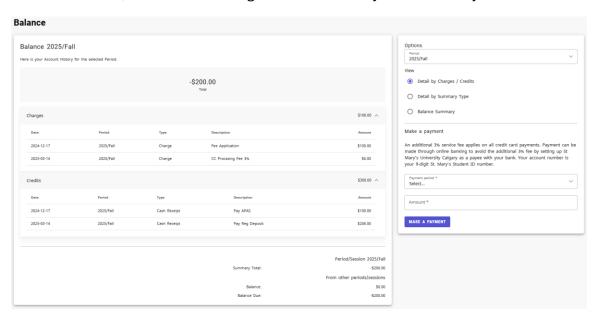
Proceed to payment



5. Enter your credit card information and click Pay



6. After your deposit is received, your account will show a balance of **-\$200**, which means you have a credit of \$200. The minus sign does not mean you owe money.



Important Information

- All credit card transactions are subject to a 3% processing fee. This will automatically be added to the charge processed on your credit card; you do not have to factor the charge in when entering the amount.
- Credit card payments can be made, using this process, for any tuition, fees, or charges incurred at St. Mary's University.
- Credit card payments are viewable on your <u>myStMU</u> account on the next business day. If
 you notice a small balance, equal to 3% of your initial payment, this is normal. The 3%
 credit card fee will clear from your account within the next business day.

Option 2: Online Banking

Online banking payments to St. Mary's University must be done as a **Bill payment**. The money is simply transferred from a holding account (chequing or savings) by your bank and deposited into St. Mary's bank account. The process does not incur a fee as St. Mary's pays for the partnership with our associated banks.

- 1. Login to your online banking account and select the account you would like to use. There will be on option to "Manage Bill Payees", "Make a Bill Payment", or "Transfers & Payments".
- 2. Ensure that the payee title is for St. Mary's in **Calgary**. This step is crucial as St. Mary's University (our institution) is very similar in title to Saint Mary's University in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Only complete the transaction if you are sure it is the correct institution. Also refer to **APPENDIX A** for more information.

3. Once you select the correct title, you will be asked to enter your **Account Number**. This will be your 9-digit Student ID number. This can be found on your admission letter in the top right corner.

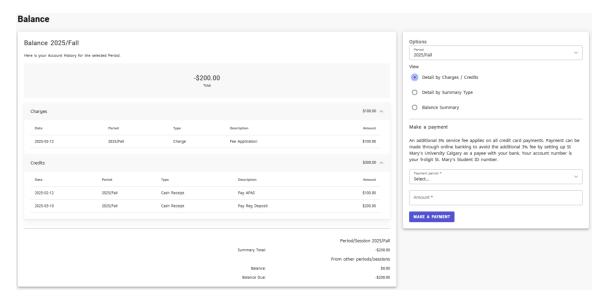

- 4. You have now successfully set up St. Mary's as a bill payee. You can proceed to make a \$200 payment to StMU for your registration deposit. Note that you must proceed to make the payment once the bill-payment is set up. Payments will not automatically be made through online banking.
- 5. After your deposit is received, your account will show a balance of **-\$200**, which means you have a credit of \$200. The minus sign does not mean you owe money.



Important Information

- Online banking payments can be made using this process, for any tuition, fees, or changes incurred at St. Mary's University.
- Please note that payments made through Online Banking may take 3 to 5 business days to process.
