


APPLICATION TIPS



Your quick guide to applying through ApplyAlberta

1. Create Your Alberta.ca Account

- Set up a BASIC Alberta.ca account (a VERIFIED account is not required)
- It's very important that the email address linked to your Alberta.ca Account is your primary and active email address, as the Admissions Office communicates with applicants exclusively via email
- Have your Alberta Student Number (ASN) ready (found in your Detailed Academic Report) or use the ASN Lookup Tool

2. Complete Your ApplyAlberta Profile

- Log in to the ApplyAlberta portal and fill out your entire profile
- If you're currently in Grade 12, be sure to include all "In-Progress" and "Planning to Take" courses, including both core and electives, that you are taking in second semester or summer school
- Include all post-secondary institutions previously attended in your academic history

3. Submit Your Application

- Select Start a New Application and select St. Mary's University
- You will be redirected to our portal to our application portal to select your program and pay the \$100 application fee (\$175 for international applicants)

CHOOSING YOUR PROGRAM

Bachelor of Education (BEd): This is an After-Degree program, which means you must already hold a recognized undergraduate degree to be eligible to apply. This program only has one intake in the Fall term each year.

Single-Entry Option (BA/BSc + BEd): If you see a program listed as BA/BSc 4-yr AND BEd 2yr, this is for Single-Entry. It's designed for students applying directly from high school who intend to complete both a 4-year Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree and the 2-year Bachelor of Education degree.

Please note: Admission to the BEd program is not guaranteed and is subject to meeting further admissions requirements.

Open Studies: To apply for Open Studies, select "Undeclared Program" as your program and choose "Open Studies" under program details.

Flexible Entry Pathway (FEP): Applicants to this pathway must meet regular high school admission requirements; however, they may substitute English 30-1 with English 30-2. Students begin in Open Studies, take three Fall courses, and upon successful completion, earn 9 credits towards an Arts and Science degree at StMU.

Minors: Selecting a minor is not required. If you do not want to declare a minor, select "_No Minor" under program details.
