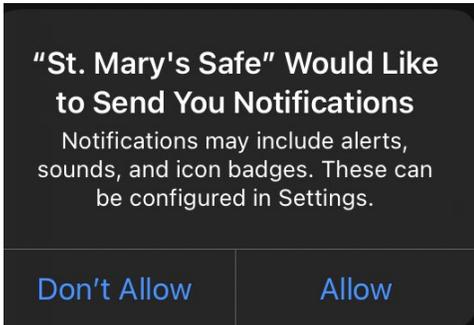

Download the App

Step 1: Search for St. Mary's Safe App in your cell phone's App store.



Step 2: Configure settings and click **Allow** notifications.



Step 3: Click on the St. Mary's App.



Step 4: The St. Mary's Safe App home screen will open.

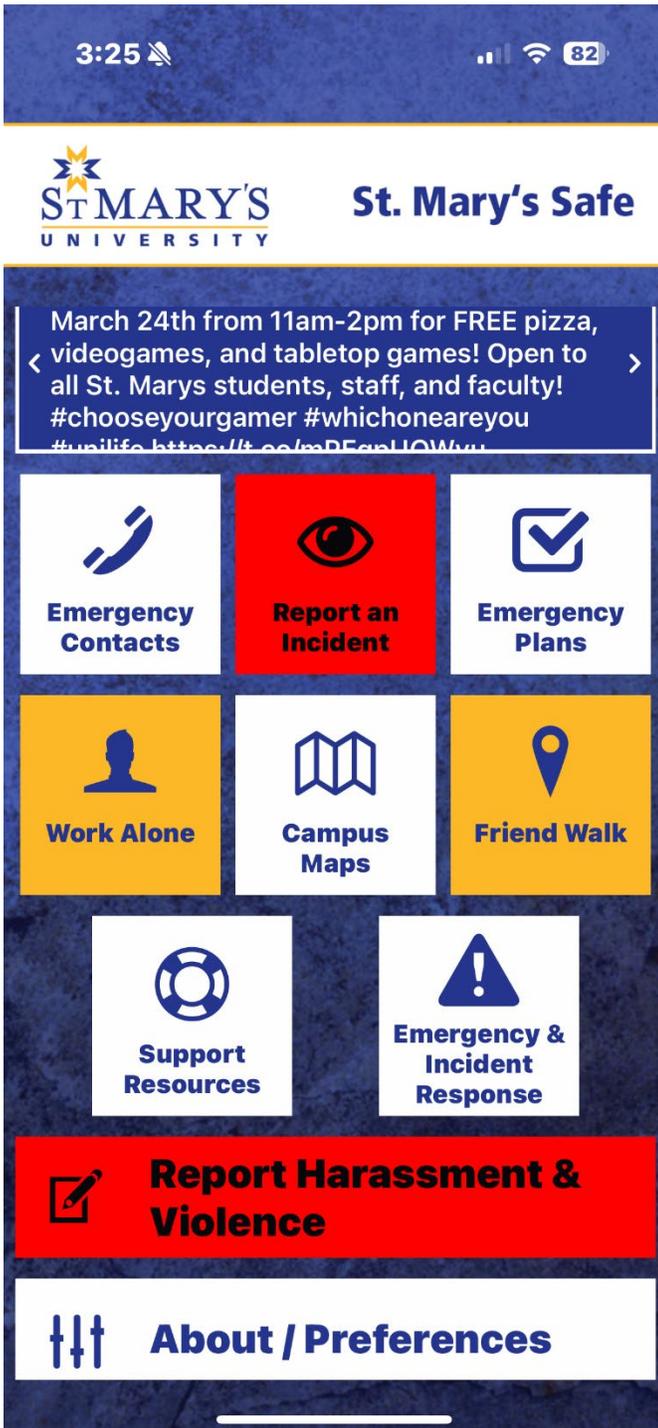


Enable Notifications

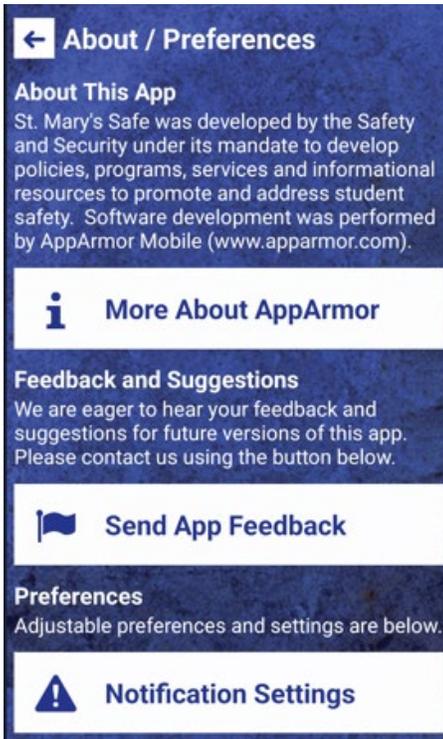
In the app

In order for you to receive test and emergency notifications, you will need to make sure you are set up to receive notifications through the app itself.

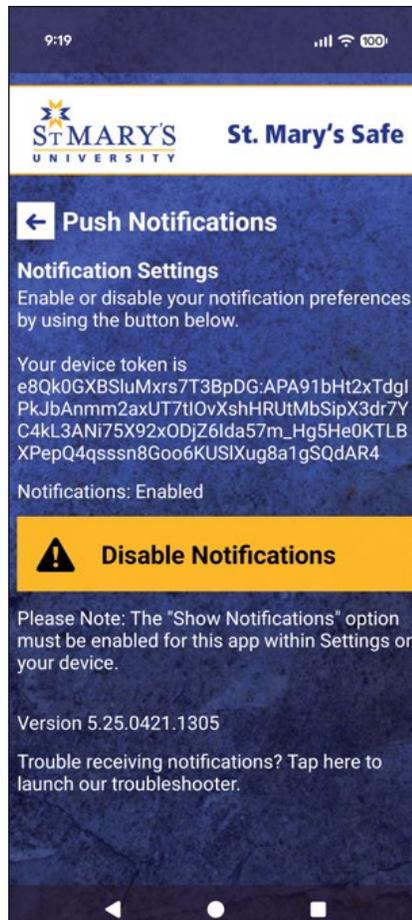
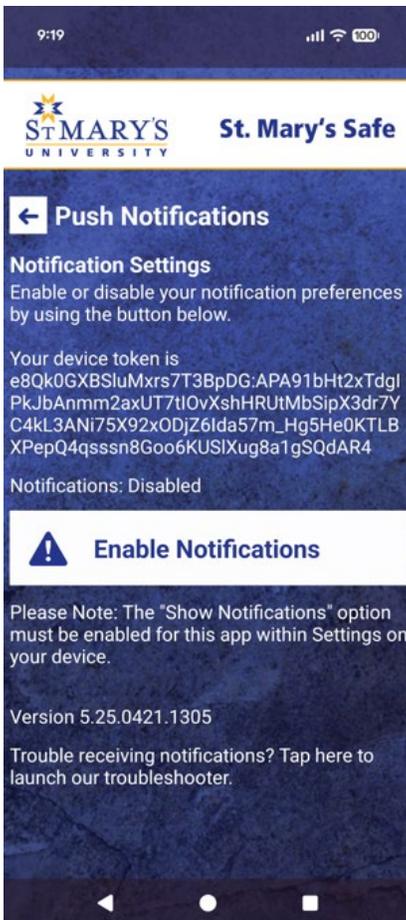
Step 1: Open the app and select 'About/Preferences'



Step 2: Select 'Notification Settings'



Step 3: Make sure Notifications are enabled. If the button is white and says 'Enable Notifications', click it to change the setting.



In your phone:

iPhone

1. Open **Settings**
2. Tap **Notifications**
3. Scroll down and select **AppArmor**
4. Turn **Allow Notifications** ON
5. Make sure **Lock Screen, Notification Centre, and Banners** are selected

Android

1. Open **Settings**
2. Tap **Apps** (or **Apps & Notifications**)
3. Select **AppArmor**
4. Tap **Notifications**
5. Make sure **Allow Notifications** is ON

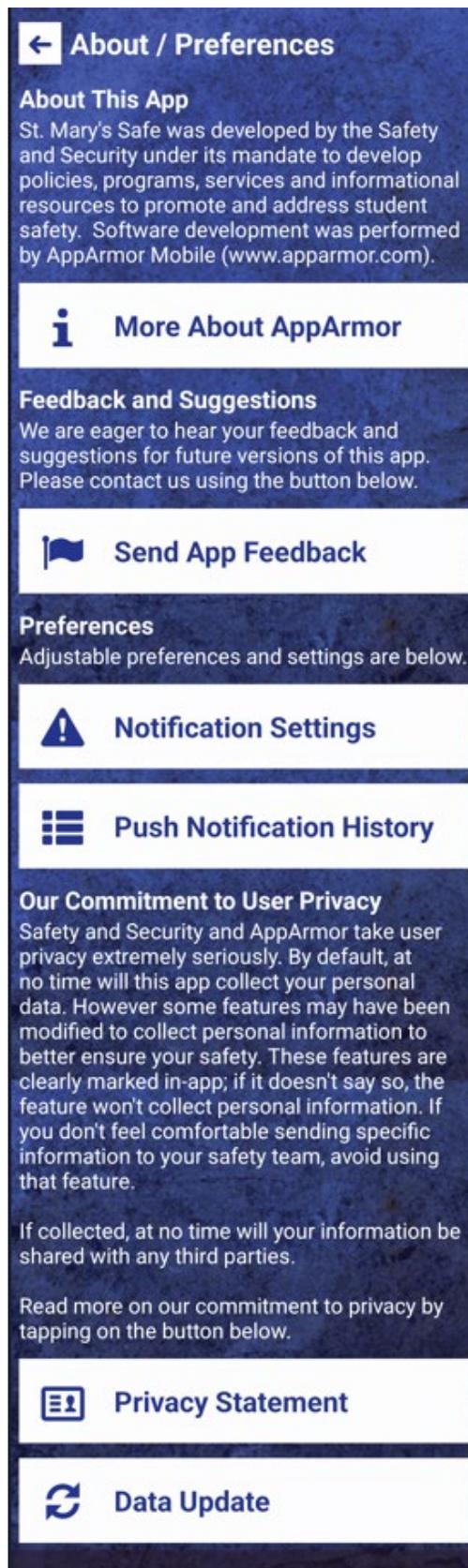
Updates:

Make sure you have manually updated your app to receive notifications.

Step 1: Open the app and select 'About/Preferences'



Step 2: Scroll to the bottom of the screen and select 'Data Update'



Step 3: Select 'Check for Updates'



Step 4: A pop up will prompt you to update the app or inform you there are no further steps to take.
