- Thank you for committing to praying for the intentions of St. Mary's University at least once a week. Our original plan was to organize guild members to pray on specific days so that each day would be equally covered in prayer. Because of the complexity of managing that process with a large group, we decided we would ask you to set your most convenient day and allow the Holy Spirit to inspire organization.
- A few of our members who prefer a daily prayer schedules and pray one section of the guild document each day. We think this is a great idea for those who need the consistency of daily routine.
- We would appreciate your commitment to pray for a minimum of one year. (But we would love to have you longer!) There is a lot of work to be done. Let's storm heaven together!
- If it is a part of your prayer devotions, we would ask that you offer the following once a month: 5 decades of the rosary, 1 Mass, 1 Hour of Adoration. Once a year, we ask that you request a Mass be said for the intentions of St. Mary's University at a local parish. (Usually arranged through the parish office.)
- You are welcome to invite others to this prayer commitment. Simply have them email prayer.guild@stmu.ca with their name and email address. (You are also welcome to forward any emails.)
